

Annexure A to Govt Order No 05 ASH of 2017 Dated 09.01.2018

**Terms & Conditions for auction of fish from Ranjit Sagar Dam for the year- 2018**

1. Any person who is state subject of Jammu and Kashmir can participate in the auction for fishing rights.
2. The Society of Fishermen registered under Cooperative Act of the J&K State, if any, can also participate in the auction.
3. The participants shall have to deposit an earnest amount of Rs. 1.00 lacs in the shape of Demand Draft favouring Assistant Director Fisheries, Kathua alongwith tender documents. The auction bid will start from the minimum bid fixed at Rs. 50.00 lacs with no upper limit
4. The Successful bidder i.e. the highest bidder shall have to deposit 50% of the e-bid amount on spot and remaining 50% amount shall be deposited by or before 20th March 2018 positively.
5. The successful bidder shall have to execute an agreement with the Department for abiding by all terms and conditions of this auction notification and other restrictions imposed under Fisheries Act on valid stamp paper duly attested by Magistrate.
6. The successful bidder i.e. the contractor shall have to engage the local registered Fishermen for fishing in the Reservoir on the basis of licence issued by the Assistant Director Fisheries Kathua.
7. For fishing in the reservoir, a maximum of 40 Nos of the small sized country boats / semi mechanized boats shall be allowed for operations in the reservoir with a maximum of two Fishermen per boat.
8. The fish caught from the reservoir shall have to be supplied and sold in local markets of adjoining areas and other major fish markets of J&K State.
9. The fishing tackle to be used in the reservoir shall be gill net with maximum 200 metres length, 3 meters breadth the minimum mesh size of 4" diameter. There shall not be any fishing activity during night hours and catching the fish below 20 cms shall be prohibited.
10. The fishing in the reservoir shall remain closed for 2 months i.e. July and August and there shall not be any fishing activities within 2 kms of rock filled concrete Dam.
11. The Department of Fisheries reserves the rights to issue special permits for Mahseer Angling by rod fishing in the Reservoir.

12. The Department of Fisheries, reserves the right to inspect the fishing boats, fishing gears, fish haul, landing centres and supply centres for imposing regulations laid down in terms and conditions and as specified in the Fisheries Act.
13. The Department of Fisheries reserves the right for imposing fine, confiscating fishing crafts and gears, fish haul etc for violation of restrictions as specified in the Auction notification.
14. The fish caught from the Reservoir shall be landed at the following landing centres viz Purthu, Sawar, Plassi.
15. The Director Fisheries, J&K Government reserves the right to accept or reject all the e-bids, including the highest one without assigning any reason and can cancel the contract, if the Terms and Conditions of the agreement are not adhered completely. The decision of Director Fisheries shall be final and binding on all concerned parties.
16. The permission for extraction of fish from the reservoir for the year 2018 shall be granted by Director Fisheries after fulfilment of all codal formalities by the successful bidder as specified in terms and conditions of the auction notification.
17. Boats shall be properly numbered and details of fisherman deputed by the contractor along with photo identity must be submitted to the designated authority before start of work.
18. No revision of rate or any other concession will be allowed in case of loss of business due to any reason whatever.
19. The contractor shall ensure all safety measures, labour law and other legal formalities and shall be responsible for breach on this account. There shall be no liability of Fisheries Department J&K for whatever damage, injury or loss to persons or belongings.
20. Proper record of manpower deployed, daily output quality and quantity wise, shall be maintained by the contractor and be submitted to the designated authority daily/weekly, along with monthly detailed reports for record and reference.
