Department in terms of SRO-43 of 2004 dated 17.02.2004.

**Government order NO: 61 -ASH of 2017**

In continuations to Government order No.187-ASH of 2015 and  
Govt. order No. 188-ASH of 2015 dated 29.12.2015, it is hereby ordered  
that:-

1. The Executive field staff of Sheep Husbandry Department who were due for time bound promotion prior to issuance of above Government orders are exempted from the condition of compulsory farm tenure for purpose of releasing the due Time Bound Promotion.
2. Female employees will be exempted from duties to alpine pastures and they shall work in the farm headquarter during summer, when livestock moves to alpines during their farm tenure.
3. In the District where there is no Farm, the District cadre executive staff/Stockmen/Assistant Stockmen shall be deputed to the farms of the adjoining District for two years farm training.
4. Any deputation from farm to field organization shall not count for farm tenure.


