In continuation to Government Order No. 39-ASH of 2018 dated 27.02.2018 issued under endorsement No. ASH/Plan/93/2017 P-I dated 27.02.2018, sanction is hereby accorded to the release of Rs. 26.7275 lakh (Rupees Twenty Six Lakh Seventy two thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Only), as **matching State** under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme "National Livestock Mission" under the activity "Fodder Production" for development of 540 hacters of land in favour of the Forest Department for its utilization during the current financial year 2017-18 on the approved activities.

The above release is subject to the fulfilment of all codal formalities, procedural norms and following conditions:-

- i. That the funds shall be utilized for execution of the scheme strictly as per originally approved components and according to Government of India's prescribed guidelines;
- ii. That the Department shall send a status report about the scheme, in terms of physical and financial progress made during the current year and up to date cumulative expenditure and physical achievement;
- iii. That the Department shall send utilization certificate of the funds released as early as possible, and definitely well before 31.03.2018;
- iv. That the Director Finance of the Department shall vouchsafe the utilization of funds as per codal procedure/ Government of India's guidelines;
- v. That the Department shall ensure that funds released are utilized prudently and judiciously and in no case they should book the expenditure just for the sake of spending;
- vi. That there shall be no cost/time over run;

- vii. That there shall be no overlapping of funding from any other source;
- viii. That the funds so released shall not be available for re-appropriation/diversion at any level; and
- ix. That there shall no expenditure on revenue or revenue like items.


