The terms of reference for the said committee are as under:

1. Drafting of breeding policy for bovines, small ruminants, equines, poultry and minor species of livestock, clearly specifying the breeding strategies and germplasm to be adopted/used in specific agri-climatic zones of the state.
2. Specify the percentage of exotic germplasm, species wise to be introduced/continued, keeping the present interim breeding policy of the state in consideration.
3. Justify any change, if proposed, from the current interim Breeding Policy of the state.

4. Recommend the breeding systems to be adopted for different species and also suggest measures for effective coordination of the animal breeding activities.
5. Recommend the type of support system for sustaining the breeding policy.

The committee will furnish their preliminary draft within a period of one month to the Chairman Jammu and Kashmir State Implementing Agency (JKSIA). Member Secretary JKSIA (Director Animal Husbandry Jammu) who shall act as Nodal officer for the said committee.


