Subject: Implementation of Judgment dated 04-05-2017 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu and Kashmir (Jammu Wing) in SWP No. 1106/2017 titled "Khurshid Ahmed V/s State and Ors".

Whereas, in the interest of administration Dr. Khurshid Ahmed I/c LDO was transferred to Doda vide Government order No. 63-ASH of 2017 dated 28/4/2017;

Whereas, aggrieved of the above order, he filed a SWP No. 1106/2017 before the Hon'ble High Court and challenged his transfer order;

Whereas the Hon'ble High Court while disposing of his writ petition passed the directions to the department on 4-5-2017 which is reproduced as under:-

"When the matter was taken up today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been transferred from one district to another and in case the petitioner joins at the new place of posting, he is required to undertake journey on foot. It is further submitted that the petitioner has submitted a representation to the respondent-1 and the aforesaid Authority may be directed to decide the representation of the petitioner by a speaking order. It is further submitted that nobody has been appointed in place of the petitioner. On the other hand, learned Dy. AG submits that the representation of the petitioner shall be dealt with in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid submissions and in the facts of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent- 1 to decide the representation submitted by the petitioner by a speaking order within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order passed today. Till the representation submitted by the petitioner is decided, the petitioner shall be allowed to continue to perform his duty at Kishtwar. It is made clear that this court has not expressed any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner".

Whereas Dr. Khurshid Ahmed I/c LDO has filed a representation in the department as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court on 04-05-2017;

Whereas the representation of the petitioner/ Doctor has been examined and considered as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court in the department and found devoid of merits and, hence rejected.


