Subject: Transfer/posting of Dr. Basharat Ahmed Malik – consideration of representation thereof.

Government Order No.: 95 -ASH of 2017

Whereas, Dr. Basharat Ahmed Malik, VAS was transferred from Gandoh to SBF Billawer vide Government Order No. 79-ASH of 2017 dated 05.06.2017;

Whereas, instead of joining at his new place of posting the said Doctor has filed an SWP No. 1486/2017 & MP No. 01/2017 before the Hon'ble High Court of J&K at Jammu;

Whereas, the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu & Kashmir while disposing of the said writ petition has passed the following directions vide its order dated 09.06.2017:-

“.....it is deemed appropriate to dispose of the writ petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation to respondent No. 2 i.e. Director, Sheep Husbandry Department, Jammu, who on receipt of the said representation would consider and decide the same in accordance with the rules and regulations applicable. In case, request is made, respondent No. 2 would also consider the feasibility of allowing the petitioner to continue at his present place of posting till such time that the decision is taken on the representation. Decision on representation be taken as expeditiously as possible preferably within 10 days from the date of submission of representation alongwith certified copy of this order”.

Whereas, in compliance to the above order the said Doctor has submitted a representation dated 03.07.2017 through his Advocate Mr. Iqbal Hussain Bhat, wherein he has represented for his transfer to Migratory post of Gandoh-Hatli (Kathua) APO Organisation;

Whereas, the Government Order No. 79-ASH of 2017 dated 05.06.2017 was issued strictly in accordance with the Transfer Policy in vogue and with due consultations of both the Directors, SHD Jammu/Kashmir;

Whereas, Dr. Basharat Ahmed Malik has mature stay for his transfer and the post held by the officer is State cadre post and the doctor is posted at SBF Billawer against a





clear vacancy in the interest of Government work and administration to provide health care to the livestock in the Sheep Breeding Farm which is crucial assignment of the Department;

Whereas, in compliance to the Hon'ble High Court order dated 09.06.2017 the department has considered and examined the representation of Dr. Basharat Ahmed Malik and found that the claim of said officer is devoid of merits and hence rejected;

Now, in view of the above, Dr. Basharat Ahmed Malik is hereby relieved and directed to join his new place of posting i.e. SBF Billawer immediately.
