Whereas, the General Administration Department vide No. GAD(Vig)36-RDA/2017 dated 21.06.2017 has forwarded communication No. VO-AH-G-11/2012-4378-79 dated 07.03.2017 of Director, Vigilance Organisation for initiation of Regular Departmental Action (RDA) against Dr. Khalid Hamid, Ex-I/C Block Veterinary Officer, Gurez in accordance with the J&K Civil Services (Classification Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956 alleging therein that the officer has:-

- i) misappropriated pay arrears
- ii) medical reimbursement
- iii) fraudulently drawal of bills;

Whereas, this department vide Government order No. 139-ASH of 2017 dated 11.10.2017 pending enquiry placed under suspension Dr. Khalid Hamid, Ex I/C Block Veterinary Officer, Gurez ;

Whereas, vide this department's Memorandum dated 9.10.2017, the officer was charge sheeted and draft article of charges, statement of imputation was served with directions to submit his reply within a period of 21 days from the date of receipt of memorandum;

Whereas, Dr. Khalid Hamid, submitted his reply to Administrative Department submitting therein that allegations leveled against him are baseless and made a request that he may be re-instated;

Whereas, Dr. Mushtaq Ahmad Shah, I/C CAHO Bandipora was appointed as Inquiry Officer vide Government order No. 172-ASH of 2017 dated 07.12.2017 to conduct enquiry against into the allegations leveled against the officer;

Whereas, the Enquiry Officer submitted report vide No. CAHO/BPR/Estt/1748-49 dated 01.01.2018 to the Administrative Department with following findings:-

1. L.A arrears amounting to Rs. 81900/- have been made immediately after clearance of road in the month of June after the gap of two months, out of which there is one month sanctioned leave and deputation order for making arrangements for cattle show at Bandipora from 25th of March, 2012;
2. Regarding possession of money draw, it is authenticated that the money was not in the personal account of the officer, but was lying in the official account of BVO Gurez
3. The complainants have fully authenticated that they received the money as mentioned in the undertakings given by them;
4. Regarding double drawal amounting to Rs. 45622/- it has happened due to clerical mistake and was rectified immediately on 14.04.2012 after it came to the notice of the concerned officer. The Enquiry Officer authenticates the claim of the doctor that there was no bill submitted to the Treasury for that drawal and even it was not entered in the drawal and acquaintance register.

Whereas, Director, Animal Husbandry Kashmir was requested to furnish his specific recommendations / comments on enquiry report submitted by the Enquiry Officer;

Whereas, Director, Animal Husbandry Department, Kashmir vide letter dated 5.2.2018 submitted that Dr. Khalid Hamid was deputed the DDO powers of BVO Gurez due to administrative constraints and certified that Dr. Khalid Hamid has not misused his official position nor committed any embezzlement of any Government money while serving as BVO Gurez and recommended that allegations / complaint against Dr. Khalid may be dropped and be reinstated from his suspension;

Whereas, Dr. Khalid Hamid Bhat Ex Block Veterinary Officer, Gurez was reinstated vide Government order No. 100-ASH of 2018 dated 16.07.2018;

Whereas, Director Animal Husbandry Kashmir again vide letter dated 14.08.2018, submitted that he did not find any embezzlement of Government money or serious financial irregularity to be attributed directly to Dr. Khalid and recommended that allegations / complaint against Dr. Khalid Bhat be dropped and the period of suspension (11.10.2017 to 15.07.2018) be treated as on Duty;

Now, therefore in view of the above, sanction is hereby accorded to treatment of period of suspension w.e.f. 11.10.2017 to 15.07.2018 as on duty and charges/allegations leveled against Dr. Khalid Hamid Bhat, Veterinary Assistant Surgeon, Animal Husbandry Department, Kashmir are hereby

dropped. However, the officer is censured under Sub Rule (1) of Rule 30 of J&K Classification, Control and Appeal Rules, 1956 with a warning to remain careful in future.
