Subject: Tentative Seniority list of Inspector Fisheries of Fisheries Department, J&K, as it stood on 01.01.2008 & 01.01.2010.

Government Order No: 98-JK(ASH) of 2021 Dated: 09.07.2021

**WHEREAS**, Jammu and Kashmir Fisheries (Non Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules were notified vide SRO-102 of 1998 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> March 1998, read with SRO-431 of 2001 dated 16.10.2001 & SRO-296 of 2008 dated 10.10.2008;

**AND WHEREAS,** as per the Schedule-I-A of the SRO-102 of 1998, the sanctioned strength of Inspector Fisheries & Equivalent in the Fisheries Department was **43** posts and by virtue of the said SRO, the post of Inspector Fisheries & equivalent is to be filled-up, 50% by direct recruitment and 50% by promotion from within the feeding service of the Fisheries Department. Therefore, the ratio between direct quota and promotion quota is 22:21 posts respectively;

AND WHEREAS, vide SRO-296 of 2008 dated 10.10.2008, the sanctioned strength of Inspector Fisheries & Equivalent in the Fisheries Department was enhanced from existing 43 posts to 59 posts, thereby increasing the sharing ratio between the two from existing 22:21 to 30:29 posts respectively i.e 30 posts for Direct recruits and 29 posts for promotions;

**AND WHEREAS,** the method of recruitment for the post of Inspector Fisheries & Equivalent, as provided in Schedule-II-A of SRO-102 of 1998 dated 23.03.1998, provides as under:-

And the method of recruitment for the post of Inspector Fisheries & Equivalent, as envisaged vide Schedule-II A(Executive) of SRO-296 of 2008 dated 10.10.2008, provides as under:-

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**AND WHEREAS,** the seniority of the members of each service as reflected in the afore-titled SRO's shall have to be regulated under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (CC&A) Rules 1956. The Head of Department have to maintain and update the seniority of service;

**AND WHEREAS,** the seniority of Inspector Fisheries & equivalent, was issued from time to time by the Director, Fisheries, J&K, has remained always under cloud of doubt on one pretext or the other, as the sharing quota between Direct Recruitment and Promotion was not properly maintained;

AND WHEREAS, one of the seniority list was issued by the Director Fisheries, J&K vide Circular No. DF/Adm-2009-1727-60 dated 27.07.2009, which was forwarded to the Administrative Department vide letter No. DF/Adm-2010-2522 dated 06.09.2010, consisting of 74 members (Inspector Fisheries & equivalent) thereby exceeding the total cadre strength viz 59 posts, and on the basis of this seniority both promotions, regular/OPG were made by the Department;

AND WHEREAS, the Department referred the case of Inspectors/equivalent to J&K PSC for placing the matter before the DPC for regularization of Inspector Fisheries as FDOs as per the rules in vogue. The J&K Public Service Commission, vide letter No. PSC/DPC/Fisheries/48/2010 dated 01.06.2011, forwarded the recommendations of the DPC/PSC;

and whereas, the recommendations of DPC/PSC could not be implemented as one Inspector Fisheries namely Mr. Manzoor Ahmad Samoon, being aggrieved of his exclusion in the recommended list approached the Hon'ble High Court by filling a writ petition No. 1897/2010 IA No. 3714/2013 titled Manzoor Ahmad Samoon Vs State challenging therein the promotion of respondents 05 to 09 being against the rules and also prayed for his inclusion in list and subsequent promotion. The matter remains subjudice before the Hon'ble High Court J&K, from 2010 to July 2015;



AND WHEREAS, during the pendency of writ petition referred above, few Inspector Fisheries approached the Hon'ble High Court, J&K, for intervention on the plea of not being the respondents in the above writ petition and no challenge thrown against their qualification / promotion as FDO and succeeded in obtaining the court order dated 07.08.2011 & 21.01.2015, in terms of which the respondent state was directed to consider the promotion of these petitioners to the post of FDO/PO in accordance with the rules;

AND WHEREAS, in compliance to Hon'ble Court orders dated 07.08.2011, & 18.12.2014, 06-Inspector Fisheries from serial 01 to 04 and serial No. 10 & 11 (not impleaded as parties) on the basis of seniority list issued in 2009, were regularized against the vacant posts of Fisheries Development Officer/equivalent vide Government Order No: 404-FST of 2013 dated 29.11.2013 & Government Order No. 14-FST of 2015 dated 21.01.2015 respectively;

AND WHEREAS, the writ petition titled Manzoor Ahmad Samoon V/s State & Ors was finally disposed off by the Hon'ble High Court Single Bench on 07.07.2015 with the following directions. The operative para is given here as under:-

#### "For reasons discussed, writ petition is allowed and;

- (i) Seniority list circulated vide No; DF/Adm/2010/2522 dated 6<sup>th</sup> September 2010 is quashed and respondents 1 & 2 directed to reframe seniority list including petitioner at serial No. 06 in seniority list i.e. ahead of respondents 05 to 09.
- (ii) Recommendation made by respondents 3 &4 as also any action taken on such recommendation is also quashed and respondents directed to consider petitioner for regularization Developments Officers ahead of respondent's 05 to 09 and made recommendation accordingly."

**AND WHEREAS,** being aggrieved of the order dated 07.07.2015 passed by the Hon'ble High Court, the respondents in above titled writ petition, namely Sh. Kulbushan Verma & Muneer Ahmad Wani filed LPA No. 157/2015 in the Hon'ble Division Bench which was finally

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disposed off by the Division Bench, the operative part of the court order is as under:-

"Based on the request of parties who wanted that the Appeal to be closed on the compromise entered between the parties, the following order was passed today and the matter was sent to the Registrar Judicial for recording the statement of the parties", which reads as follows:-

- 1. Application (MP No. 01/2017) has been filed seeking settlement of this Letters Patent Appeal in terms of affidavits of appellants and respondent No. 8 wherein it is stated that the parties have resolved the issue amongst themselves.
- 2. In this view of the matter, the Registrar Judicial is directed to record the statement of the parties after proper identification and place the same before the Court today itself.
- 3. Let the parties present themselves before the Registrar Judicial for recording their statement"

"That with the intervention of the senior officials in the department now the deponents have agreed to resolve the controversy by mutually satisfactory disposition of the controversy, in that the deponents have mutually accepted that deponent No. 1 shall take position No. 5 in the seniority list deponent No. 2 shall take seniority position at Serial No. 6, whereas the deponent No. 3 shall take seniority position at Serial No. 7 in the seniority is regarding which dispute has arisen, and this mutually agreed disposition is acceptable to the department as well and the department is willing to address the controversy by accepting the mutually agreed disposition".

In this view of the matter, the Letters Patent Appeal (LPA) as between the above two parties shall stand settled and is-disposed off in the aforesaid terms along with all connected MPs. We make it clear that the aforesaid statement will have no binding effect on other employees who are not parties to the LPA and the consequent settlement.

In view of the above, the interim directions, if any, shall stand vacated. The Respondent-Department is at liberty to proceed further as per law.

**AND WHEREAS,** another writ petition titled SWP No. 191/2017 was filed by Direct Recruiters namely Farkhanda Wani V/s State challenging therein retrospective promotions of some of the

Inspectors from Sr. No 40 to 50 w.e.f. 01.01.2006, besides, exceeding promotion quota and prayed for quashment of the same,

**AND WHEREAS,** the Hon'ble High Court Jammu wing, on 06.02.2017 had passed following interim order in the above referred SWP No. 191/2017;

"Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners submit that promotions are being made in violation of rules. In view of the aforesaid submissions and in the fact of the case, status quo shall be maintained with regard to the promotions to the post of the Fisheries Development Officer till next date of hearing."

passed in SWP No: 1897/2010 and LPA 157/2015, the Department of Fisheries, J&K, issued another final seniority list of Inspector Fisheries and equivalent vide notification No. 01 of 2019 dated 16.04.2019, and forwarded the same to Administrative Department for placing the cases of eligible Inspectors before DPC/PSC for their confirmation as FDO/equivalent.

AND WHEREAS, the department referred the case of Inspector Fisheries and equivalent to J&K PSC for placing the matter before the DPC for regularization of Inspector Fisheries as Fisheries Development Officers as per the rules in vogue;

and whereas, the case was discussed in the preliminary meetings held on 04.12.2019, 10.12.2020, 18.12.2020, 12.01.2021 & 12.02.2021, and the DPC could not reach to any conclusion in view of the dispute of the seniority list and fresh SWP No. 191/2017 titled Farkhanda Wani V/s State and Ors pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu wing;

and whereas, the posts of Inspector Fisheries and equivalent, have been filled up mostly from promotion quota and only 05 officials have been appointed from direct quota, thereby violated the norms and rules of which the Administrative Department has already taken cognizance and inquiry has been ordered;

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AND WHEREAS, the guidelines issued vide cabinet decision No. 186/15 dated 27.11.2001 issued under Government Order No. 107-GAD of 2002 dated 16.01.2002 clearly indicates as under:-

- i. No quota be diverted from one cadre of appointment to another and wherever it has been diverted, the same should be restored to each source in future.
- ii. It must be also ensured that no promote(s) is put in the direct recruitment quota temporarily or on stop-gap or adhoc basis when such direct recruitment posts have not been referred to the PSC/SSB.

AND WHEREAS, the case has been examined in the Department and it has been observed that no person can be promoted with retrospective effect from a date when he was not born in the cadre that too against the direct slots so as to adversely affect others;

AND WHEREAS, the instant case was referred to the Law Department for comments/suggestion. The Department of Law, Justice & Parliamentary Affairs vide letter No. LD(Ser) 2018/122-ASH dated 22.01.2019 conveyed as under:-

"the department shall have to consider and decide the objections received from all the officers/officials in accordance with law and settle the seniority of officer/officials at all levels in terms of rule-24 of J&K Civil Service (CC&A) Rules 1956 while doing so the department shall ensure that no court directions are violated."

against the post of Inspectors without strictly following the quota system even in respect of the rules in vogue prior to the existing rules the continuous officiating of these Officers against these posts had added to the complexity of the problem with regard to working out the quota from the relevant streams to the extent admissible under rules;

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**AND WHEREAS,** the whole matter was considered in light of the rules and it was observed that the seniority issued vide Notification No. 01 of 2019 dated 16.04.2019, did not stand the test of the rules prescribed from time to time;

AND WHEREAS, in view of the peculiar situation faced by the department as a consequence of litigations and excess utilization of quota as consequence of above shall be subsumed in future and neutralized by a given date as the case may be with the approval of the Competent Authority.

### **NOW THEREFORE:-**

- i. The seniority issued vide Circular No. DF/Adm-2009-1727-60 dated 27.07.2009 and notification No. 01 of 2019 dated 16.04.2019 is hereby rescinded *ab-initio* and a fresh tentative seniority list(s) is issued, which has been drawn from two sources i.e. from promotion quota and direct quota as per the ratio prescribed as it stood on 01.01.2008 and 01.01.2010 as per the existing rules;
- ii. The Director Fisheries, J&K, shall refrain from promoting any official of the Fisheries Department to the post of Inspector Fisheries and equivalent till the required Direct Quota is not maintained as per the sharing ratio (50:50) of the total sanctioned cadre strength of the service;
- The tentative seniority list of the officials, restricted to the total sanctioned cadre strength of the service i.e 43 posts (22:21) as on 01.01.2008 and 59 posts (30:29) as on 01.01.2010, forming **Annexure-"A"** & **Annexure-"B"** respectively to this order, is issued for the information of the concerned. The seniority position/date has been assigned strictly as per their initial appointments, eligibility and availability of posts and rules in vogue.



Any official not satisfied with the position assigned to him/her in the tentative seniority list may file objections, if any, before the Principal Secretary to the Government, Animal/Sheep Husbandry & Fisheries Department, with documentary support to his/her claim within a period of 07 days from the date of issuance.

The Date of birth indicated against the officials in the tentative seniority list shall not be taken authentic for determination of age, which shall and shall have reference with the date of birth recorded in the service book.

This is issued without prejudice to the outcome of the writ petition(s) pending, if any, before any competent court of law and subject to the outcome of such writ petition(s).
