**Government Order No. 110 - JK (APD) of 2022**

**Dated: 15-07-2022**

Sanction is hereby accorded to the release of ₹1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) in favour of Chief Executive Officer, Livestock Development Board (LDB's) Jammu / Kashmir for meeting the expenditure for publicity and organization of farmers awareness Camp under Rashtriya Gokul Mission as per following break up:-

02	Livestock Development Board, Kashmir	₹70,000.00

The funds so allotted are released through Public Financial Management System (PFMS) in favour of Chief Executive Officer, Livestock Development Board, Jammu / Kashmir.

The above allotment/release is subject to following conditions: -

- The Funds shall be utilized by the Livestock Development Boards in accordance with broad guidelines of the Scheme RGM available on website www.dahd.nic.in.
- Physical targets with respect to the sanctioned activity components will be reviewed by the UT government keeping in view the sanctioned amount, current cost as well as actual requirement.
- The Livestock Development Boards Jammu / Kashmir will give details of the district-wise physical and financial targets on the basis of the actual requirement of each district in the micro plan.
- The funds shall be utilized strictly following all codal formalities /GFR in vogue.
- The Central funds may be utilized strictly as per approved activities & Budget for the year. If any inter component re-appropriation becomes necessary, prior approval of Govt. of India is prerequisite.
- Livestock Development Boards shall refund interest accrued from funds released under the scheme. As per Rule 230(8) of GFR 2017, " all interests or other earnings against grants- in- aid should be mandatorily remitted to the Consolidated Fund of Government of India immediately instead of adjusting against future releases".
- The J&K SIA and Livestock Development Board Jammu / Kashmir will maintain subsidiary accounts of Government grant. The Ministry of Finance has formulated standard formats for presentation of final accounts by Central Autonomous Organization. The institute will maintain and present their annual accounts in prescribed formats.
- The accounts of Jammu & Kashmir State Implementing Agency / Livestock Development Board Jammu / Kashmir shall be open to inspection by sanctioning authority and central audit by Controller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C & A.G. (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India.
- The certificate of actual utilization of grants for the purpose for which it is sanctioned shall be submitted by Livestock Development Boards in GFR 12A {Rule 238(1)}form

- towards the closure of financial year alongwith component-wise statement of expenditure and quarterly progress report to this department for onwards submission to Joint Secretary C&DD, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, New Delhi, GOI.. Utilization certificates in above prescribed format shall also be uploaded on PFMS.
- x. Performance-cum-Achievement report should be submitted after utilization of this grant.
- xi. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government grants except those declared as obsolete and unserviceable or condemned in accordance with the procedure laid down in GFR shall not be disposed off without obtaining the prior approval of the designated authority, which sanctioned the grant.
- xii. The further use of Grant in Aid being released by this sanction order is to be done through EAT module of PFMS. The UC not supported by EAT module data is likely to be rejected and expenditure is not to be treated as regular. The Boards would be forced to refund the amount received as the expenditure not appearing in EAT module data is not to be considered as expenditure incurred in accordance with the terms and conditions of this sanction order.
- xiii. Livestock Development Board, Jammu / Kashmir shall provide information on number of people belonging to Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Women who are benefited from the scheme on quarterly basis.


